Code of Conduct 2025

Skating is fun—but safety comes first. All skaters participate at their own risk.

✓ General Rules

- Follow all instructions from Ice Stewards and WWL staff.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult (18+); children under 6 must have an adult with them on the ice.
- Access to the rink is at the discretion of WWL staff. Their decisions are final.
- Tickets are non-refundable and non-exchangeable. If asked to leave for misconduct, no refund will be issued.
- If you have concerns, ask to speak with the WWL Supervisor.

O Prohibited Behaviors & Items

- No littering or loitering. No food, drinks, tobacco, or gum on the rink.
- No entry without skates. No headphones, phones, cameras, or bags on the rink.
- No climbing or sitting on dasher board walls.
- No carrying others, including children.
- No games (e.g., tag), chain skating (more than three holding hands), or disruptive behavior.
- No shouting, swearing, spitting, fighting, bullying, vandalism, or petting.
- No skating under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Skating Etiquette & Safety

- Always skate in an anti-clockwise direction.
- Keep moving—no stopping or sitting on the ice.
- Control your speed and stay alert to others and obstacles.
- Know your limits and skate within them.
- Leave the rink during resurfacing, at session end, or when directed by staff.
- Avoid altercations and maintain respectful conduct.
- Bike helmets, knee pads, and elbow pads are permitted.
- If you fall over, keep you hands close to your body and wait for assitance from our team

Assumption of Risk

Skating is inherently risky. By entering the rink, skaters and spectators alike accept the possibility of injury, including:

- Collisions with other skaters or individuals
- Falls
- Contact with objects or rink structures

WWL management and VISAR are not liable for any injury or loss.
